Mostly purple plants, with 20% variegated or green plants make a great color combo. Leaves avg. 1 1/2-3" at full size. AAS winner. Ht. 16-18".




Dahlia Dahlia pinnata



#### Parsley Petroselinum crispum


Italian(plain)

The very best broad celery-leaf type with flat, glossy, dark green leaves. Its erect, vigorous growth and strong flavor make it the favorite for flavoring.










Winner of a 2012 All America Selection award, Summer Jewel Pink is a dwarf annual sage with super-abundant blooms of soft powder pink.

Sweet Pea Lathyrus odoratus


AAS Winner. Multicolor chard. Stems of many colors including gold, pink, orange, purple, red and white. Lightly savoyed leaves with a mild taste.

Dark red fruit, disease resistant and a standard cherry for Spring Ledge field production. An improvement over 'Sweet 100' in quantity and quality of fruits.
